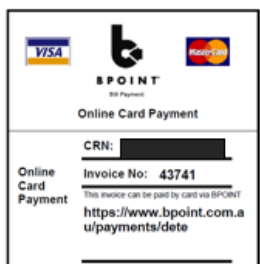
Administration will be sending home a note on Friday, 31 October 2019 requesting notification if your child/children will be leaving the school in 2020.
