On the 7<sup>th</sup> November 2016, will be preparing and tasting a number of "Bush Tucker" foods as part of our History unit. In History, Year Two students are learning about the local area.

During this session the students will *explore a site of historical significance in the local community and describe what the site reveals about the past and its importance today. They will learn to pose questions about the past and use sources provided to answer these questions, and to use information gathered to develop an understanding about the past.*

Activity details:

- Activity details – 7<sup>th</sup> November 2016 at the school oval.
- Level of Risk for all activities – Medium
- Students will be tasting and preparing bush tucker to taste
- Students will not be using hazardous materials to prepare food as it will be prepared by staff.
- Students will be on the Junior School Oval
- The activity will be led by **Sunshine Coast Environmental Education Centre**
- Students will remain in the school grounds
- Students will need to wear full school uniform, black closed in shoes and have a sun safe hat.
- Students are asked to wear sunscreen and bring a water bottle.
- Due to conditions such as allergies or anaphylaxis, students with allergies will not be sampling any bush tucker

Activity Costs:

The activity costs \$5.00 to cover the food and resources supplied to the students. **Final Payment is due by the 31<sup>st</sup> of October 2016.**
