This funding will be used to


- Employ staff to improve teacher effectiveness in the teaching of writing.
- Employ staff (teacher aides, Guidance Officer and ST:L&N) to support student engagement.
- Increase the percentage of Yr3&5 students meeting NAPLAN NMS in reading and writing to 100%.
- Increase the percentage of students in NAPLAN upper two bands in Writing to:
 - Yr3 - 50%.
 - Yr5 – 20%.
- Introduce an observation / feedback culture with a particular focus on Literacy and Numeracy. Admin, HOC and ST:L&N's to provide coaching through performance development process.


Our initiatives include

- Engage a writing coach and extra ST:L&N to provide coaching to teachers to deepen teachers' understandings of the writing cycle by providing targeted instruction to ensure highly effective strategies of essential reading and writing concepts and skills are delivered in every classroom.
- Create leadership structure (DPs and ST:L&N) to lead the development of teachers' capability to embed feedback in the teaching and learning cycle using Marzano's Design Questions.
- Whole school approach to providing intensive support to extend students demonstrating high levels of achievement and staff will provide focused and intensive teaching for students requiring additional support to demonstrate achievement against the year-level achievement standards
- Using TAs to support the Literacy Block to improve reading and writing results of students using MiniLit and MacqLit programs

Our school will improve student outcomes by

• Employing DP (0.3FTE) to monitor student achievement, lead curriculum development, develop teacher capacity and provide consistent approaches to literacy and numeracy in P-2	\$ 44000
• Employing a writing coach	\$ 10100
• extra 1.2 FTE ST:L&N to increase teacher effectiveness	\$100740
• Engaging teacher aides to support student learning in literacy blocks	\$147200
• Employ Guidance Officer extra 0.1 FTE to support social emotional wellbeing of students	\$7602
